Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA) 200-125 (new curriculum) validates the ability to install, configure, operate, and troubleshoot medium-size route and switched networks, including implementation and verification of connections to remote sites in a WAN. CCNA curriculum includes basic mitigation of security threats, introduction to wireless networking concepts and terminology, and performance-based skills. The new curriculum includes (but is not limited to) the use of these protocols: IP, Enhanced Interior Gateway Routing Protocol (EIGRP), Serial Line Interface Protocol Frame Relay, Routing Information Protocol Version 2 (RIPv2), VLANs, Ethernet, access control lists (ACLs)..

You may choose one of the following programs to achieve your certification.

Weekday evening, Weekend or Boot camp classes are available. Once you complete the course class assistance is available until you get certified.

Cisnet offers exam preparation class with model questions, labs and practical sessions with routers and switches. All these services are free of cost once you register with the CCNA course
